

SESSIONAL WORKER

Job Description and Person Specification

The post-holder will assist in the delivery of a range of services to young carers in Fife on a sessional basis, primarily focussing on the co-facilitation of group-work activities and occasional one to one emotional support as required.

Reporting directly to the Support Worker, the post holder will be part of a team of staff and volunteers all of whom will be expected to contribute to the design and delivery of services to young carers and development of the organisation. The Support Worker will provide regular support and supervision on an individual basis.

Work is completed mainly in the evenings during term time and during the day during school holiday periods.

The post-holder must be willing to commit to at least one group a fortnight based within **Levenmouth**, **Glenrothes**, **Dunfermline**, **Cupar and Kirkcaldy**, **Fife**.

A full disclosure check through the PVG scheme is mandatory.

Salary is £12p/h.
